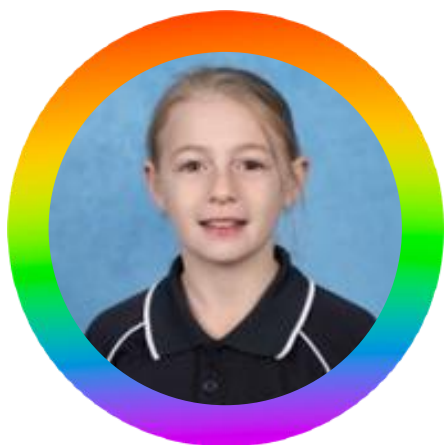
## STEM AWARDS
